



FUN RIDE TERMS & CONDITIONS 2019

Start times will be on ticket

- On arrival riders should report to the fun ride secretary's marquee to register and collect their number.
- Horses/ponies must be over 4 years of age and have current valid vaccination certificates.
- Horses/ponies must have third party insurance.
- Horses/ponies must be sound and in good health.
- All tack must be safe and in a good state of repair.
- **Riding hats are compulsory and must up to the current BS and EN standard (EN1384/BSEN1384)**
- **Body protectors are compulsory if you are jumping and must up to the current BS and EN standard (EN1384/BSEN1384)**
- Entry fee does not include admission to the SsangYong Blenheim Palace Horse Trials 2019.
- Once a fun ride ticket has been purchased you will receive a discount code to order two free Thursday admission tickets to the SsangYong Blenheim Palace Horse Trials.
- Numbers must be worn throughout the ride.
- All riders must report to the first steward at the beginning and end of their ride.
- Jumps may only be jumped in the direction indicated by the flagging (red flag on right, white flag on left).
- All jumps are optional, but only three attempts are allowed at each.
- Riders who retire on route must inform the nearest steward.
- Riders are requested to respect the land owners' generosity in letting the land. The route will be clearly marked and supervised by stewards. Please take care and stay off crops and verges and follow all directional signage.
- Riders must carry out instructions given to them by the course stewards.
- Entry fees are non-refundable unless due to the cancellation of the fun ride. A waitlist will be held. Replaced entries will be refunded less an admin fee of £15.
- The Organising Committee, officials and volunteers do not accept liability for any accident, damage, injury, theft or illness to horses, riders, owners, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.
- Paramedics, vets and a farrier will be on call.
- Horses must not be tied up and left unattended outside of their box/trailer and **MUST** clean up hay and droppings.
- Dogs must be kept on leads at all times and cannot accompany riders on the route.
- By entering the class, riders agree for any photographs, or video's taken during the competition to be used in future editorials, marketing, etc.
- **Entries will not be taken on the day**
